

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

As I reflect on the past year, it's hard to find adequate words to describe a year that turned life as we know it upside down.

At the beginning of 2020, TMYL was preparing to add to our already robust programming in order to increase our impact on the underresourced children in Lansing. Plans included adding Dwight Rich School of the Arts in the Lansing School District to our Lunch Time Tennis Program, exposing 700 more children to the game of tennis while helping them remain active; an increased commitment and deepening of the relationship with our partner schools in Lansing, and collaborating with new partners, including the Boys & Girls Clubs and the YMCA, in our summer program. But then, everything came to a screeching halt.



In March, when it became clear that life would need to change, we were both sad and concerned. Sad, because we would miss spending time with the kids we serve and concerned for what the future held – for TMYL as an organization, but most importantly, concerned for all of the children in our area who would miss out on opportunities to learn and grow. We knew that we HAD to shift our programming and resources to meet the new needs of our community.

Through the commitment and creativity of our staff and Board, we did just that! Our programs shifted to a virtual platform and staff time was concentrated on personal outreach and providing resources (equipment, books, tablets, information, etc.) to our families. Meanwhile, our donors stepped up to ensure TMYL could continue to operate and thrive during a time of turmoil.

Ultimately, 2020 solidified that TMYL is not merely an organization dispensing programming, but a family. A family of participants, families, staff, donors, board members, and volunteers who rely on and support one another, who provide whatever resources and expertise they have available to benefit those who need assistance, and who genuinely care for each other.

As we enter 2021, we know things remain uncertain and are prepared to stay nimble in our programming to meet the most critical needs of our participants while following safety regulations. But as we return to the schools and courts to serve our kids, we will hold on to the lessons we have learned. As an organization, we strive to always meet our participants and their families where they are, and this year certainly reinforced how critical it is to tailor our programming and efforts where our children most need it.

We are grateful for your support of TMYL! And while the future remains unclear, one thing remains certain – that with your ongoing assistance, we will continue to make a positive impact on the community by helping kids in Lansing who need it most!





COVID-19 PROGRAMS AND RESPONSE

When everything shut down in Michigan in mid-March, TMYL's tennis and education programs all quickly shifted to a virtual platform to continue providing services to our youth. We focused on providing significant training for our coaches and tutors to ensure program effectiveness and impact. We transitioned several staff members to exclusively focus on outreach to families – phone calls, emails, text messages, and equipment drop-off. TMYL FINANCIALS


While we had a slight (understandable) decrease in revenue for 2020, it was off-set by a decrease in expenses. Even during a tumultuous time, TMYL continued to take steps to diversify our funding sources. We made a concerted effort to seek out more grant opportunities and succeeded! In 2020 grants made up 28% of our total revenue compared to 11% in 2019. In addition to grants, over 200 individuals and businesses supported TMYL through both direct and in-kind contributions.

Your contributions to TMYL have been invaluable. We hope we can count on you to partner with us to spread the word and expand our donor base. The more resources we have, the more children we can reach!






Number of Donors by Donation Level






2020 Revenue
