## SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. Scholarships for Parks and Recreation Leisure Service Programs are for:
  - A. Persons under the age of 18
  - B. Lansing residents living within the Corporate City Limits and who meet the Federal Housing and Urban Development low income guidelines for the Lansing area. (Applicant may be required to show proof of income and residency)

## Current HUD Income Limits \*\*Bridge Cards and WIC Cards qualify as verification

- C. Eligible activities offered by the Lansing Parks and Recreation Department
- D. Individual fees. (Scholarships do not cover team fees, added on supply costs, field trips, out-of-town trips or one day activities.)
- E. A \$60.00 maximum in any 3 months/season within a fiscal year, maximum benefit per individual is not to exceed \$240 in any fiscal year. If in doubt, verify in household history.
- 2. Minimum contributions for Parks Activity Scholarships will be as follows:

<sup>\*</sup> Activities/programs established with a family rate shall permit the family to receive the individual scholarship only. If an individual of the family also applies for an individual activity/program fee, the prorated family scholarship shall be credited towards the \$60.00 maximum in any three month period.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Remember the maximum is \$60 per three months/season. If a person is registering for a \$85 program, the maximum scholarship is \$60.00. The person would have to contribute a minimum of \$25.00 instead of the \$20.00 for an activity costing \$35.01+. The \$60 full scholarship only applies to a single program with a cost of \$80 or more.
