DEADLINE FOR PERMISSION SLIP Permission slips must be turned into the Letts, Lansing Catholic, or Quentin Park site directors by TUESDAY, July 30, 2019, in order to go to the Boys' Nationals Community Day.

FIELD TRIP RULES:

1. Each child must have a signed field trip permission slip from a parent/guardian before going on the trip.
2. Participants must ride the bus to the field trip location and return home on the bus. No participant will be released to a relative or friend they may meet at the field trip location without written parental permission.
3. Participants must obey the rules set by Lansing Parks and Recreation and the Todd Martin Youth Leadership Program Directors. If any participant refuses to cooperate or is disruptive, the parents may be called to pick their child up at the field trip location and may not be allowed to attend future field trips. Lansing Parks and Recreation and the Todd Martin Youth Leadership Program Directors reserve the right to deny any child or adult eligibility to participate in any activity if any of the above rules are violated.
